

## Key Points to Know

- ◆ 2017 Pick-Up Weeks:
  - Oct. 23 through Oct. 27
  - Oct. 30 through Nov. 3
  - Nov. 6 through Nov. 10
  - Nov. 13 through Nov. 17
- ◆ Website will be updated daily with the weekly pick-up schedule. \* [www.plainfield-township.com](http://www.plainfield-township.com) click on the Highway link.
- ◆ Leaves will be picked up at least one time during each pick-up week.
- ◆ Eligible households are those where the Plainfield Township Highway Department snow plows the unincorporated street(s) in front and/or just the side of your home. Only leaves placed on the unincorporated streets will be picked up.
- ◆ Rain, freezing conditions, or snow may alter, delay, or permanently halt the leaf collection at any time.



## Plainfield Township Highway Department “Leaf Pick-Up Program”

Eligible households in unincorporated Plainfield Township are able to take part in this free service which begins on October 23, 2017.

To help ensure a smooth and successful program, the guidelines below must be followed:



- Leaves must be placed at the **edge** of the street but **not in the street** by 7:00 a.m. Monday morning during each pick-up week.
- Piles set out for pick up must contain leaves **only**. Other types of yard waste or burned leaves mixed in the leaf piles will not be picked up.
- The program is designed to help eliminate burning leaves on township streets and in yards as well as help eliminate smoke pollution.
